



Bowen Lake Bridge & Turnpike


- 20-Foot Single-Stringer Bridge Replaced

Broken Thumb Bridge Replacement




- 22-Foot Bridge Replaced

Challenger-Discovery Boardwalk Repairs

- Replaced 53 Rotten Planks
- Repaired 40 Feet of Collapsed Railing
- Levelled out Leaning Section of Boardwalk
- 5 Staff and 3 Volunteers over 2 Days



High-Lonesome Hut Access Trail Reroute

- 200 Feet of New Trail Reroute Constructed
- Decommissioned 730 Feet of Unsustainable Routes
- Removed 27 Trees and Cleared 7 Drains
- 5 Staff and 6 Volunteers over 2 Days



Gilsonite Bridge & Turnpike Replacement



- Replaced 20-Foot Bridge that Burned in the East Troublesome Fire
- Replaced 30-Foot Turnpike that also Burned
- Completed in Partnership with the USFS
- 8 Staff over 2 Days



Strawberry Lake Trail

- 50-Feet of New Turnpike Constructed
- 43 Timber Check-Steps Installed
- 68 Drains Cleared or Constructed
- Completed in Partnership with VOC
- 7 Staff and 48 Volunteers over 3 Days



Buffalo Creek Bridge Replacement



- Replaced 46-Foot Long Multi-Span Bridge that burned in the East Troublesome Fire
- 2,600 Feet of Trail Surface Restoration
- Completed in Partnership with the USFS on NPLD
- 8 Staff and 33 Volunteers over 3 Days

- Over 400 volunteers

- Replaced a 46' multi-span bridge on Buffalo Creek Trail with the USFS
- Cleaned 15 miles of the Upper CO River with the BLM from Pumphouse
- Windy Gap Trash Cleanup, Weed Mitigation, and Tread Restoration with CPW
- Restored 110' of burn area trail on Green Mountain in Rocky Mountain National Park with NPS
- Fraser River and Vasquez Creek Cleanup with Trout Unlimited and Headwaters River Journey



31st Annual Grand County National Public Lands Day

- Restored 1400' of Trail Surface on Gore Canyon Trail with the BLM
- Noxious Weed Mitigation and Native Seed Collection with the Town of Fraser
- Boardwalk CDT Branding with the Town of Grand Lake and CDTC
- Stained and Repaired a Fence on the Fraser River Trail with the Town of Winter Park
- 30+ Bags of Trash removed on Berthoud Pass with Friends of Berthoud Pass
- “Weathered” PBS Documentary Viewing and Panel Discussion with Local Fire Experts
